“A Note from the Pastor”

Dear Family and Friends of CUMC,

In 2008, our church experienced many blessings in the areas of ministries as we served the Lord and the people who entered our doors. New programs and ministries were offered to our members, special guests and to those in our community. The following will provide you with a glimpse of what we’ve accomplished regarding the new programs:

- A four-week computer class led by Christine Bertino on “Intro to the Internet”
- Preteen Mid-week ministry led by David Montemayor and Lucy Vetrone
- Guitar lessons for children led by David Montemayor
- Liturgical Dance Classes led by Choreographer/Instructor Traci Hall
- English as a Second Language led by Ms. Lisa and Stephanie Clark

There are several other programs not mentioned above that have been a blessing and have contributed to our growth at CUMC. The growth I’m speaking about is not only in numbers, but in our spiritual growth as well. I’m speaking about programs/ministries such as the All-Church-Breakfast offered to all every last Sunday of the month, the “coffee fellowship time” held in our Wesley Hall 30 minutes prior to our worship service, bible studies for all ages on Sunday mornings, the High Noon Bible Study held on Mondays at 12 p.m., Disciple Bible study held on Monday evenings, the Youth Fellowship group and Confirmation Class. I’m sure I’m still missing some but at least I wanted to give you an idea that we are accomplishing a lot with the resources we have at CUMC; the greatest resource being the volunteers who do so not for recognition, but because they love the Lord and receive His blessings as they wholeheartedly serve others.

This New Year of 2009 will be full of challenges but they can be seen as opportunities for obtaining victories in the life of our church. It will mostly depend on

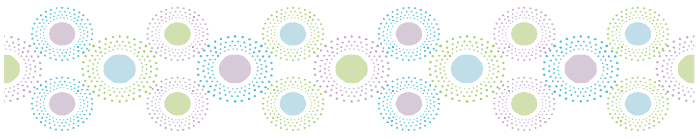
how we (the church) respond. For example, (1) it is expected for Jubilee Presbyterian Church to vacate our church and move into their new location in Norristown around June. (2) The economy has startled people in such a way that many are holding on to some of their finances which would normally be used to share it with non-profit organizations (one of these organizations being the local church). These two examples may cause some of you to think that we will not accomplish the goals we’ve set for the New Year in each areas of ministry.

One of the ways we can change this thinking is for you to be willing to “step up to the plate” to assist our teams; no matter what your age may be. Here are some ways you can take this step:

- Pray, Pray and Pray (God moves when His people talk AND listen to Him)
- Believe in the words that are found in the paper bills (In God We Trust) and commit to giving God’s portion to the local church to support our programs and ministries
- Volunteer for one or some of the various program opportunities offered at CUMC (Examples are: Sunday School*, Nursery during worship service*, stuffing/labeling envelopes, chaperoning on children and/or youth trips, assist in fundraising events, etc.) Look for these and other volunteer opportunities in our weekly worship bulletins, monthly newsletters, church website or by “word of mouth”.

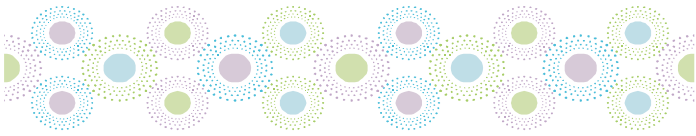

HOSPITAL VISITS**

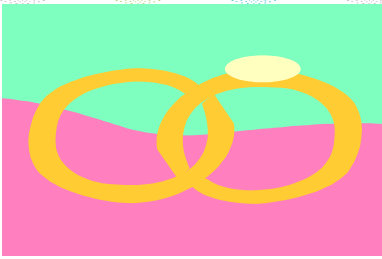

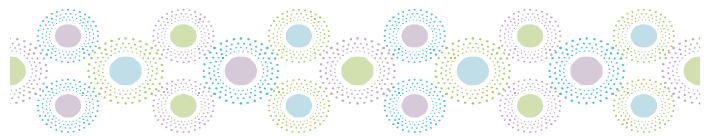


NEEDLEWORK CIRCLE

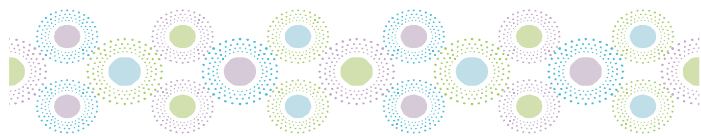
Speaking English in Conshohocken

Have you heard about one of the newest ministries at the CUMC? In the fall of 2008 the newly formed ESL Ministry began offering English as a Second Language (ESL) classes to Conshohocken community members. The goal of the ministry is to help immigrants to better communicate and incorporate themselves and their families into our community by teaching English language along with American culture.

Last fall the ministry offered two different levels of classes to approximately 15 people. Two-hour evening classes were held twice a week at each level from September through December. These classes were taught by community volunteers Stephanie Clark and Lisa Steinhauer.

In winter/spring of 2009 the ESL Ministry plans will continue to offer English classes, and we invite you to get involved! You can volunteer with us in many different ways. As a conversation partner you can attend a class on occasion to help a student to practice in a short, one-on-one setting. As nursery helper, you can volunteer to play with and care for the students' children, freeing their parents to concentrate on the lesson. As tutor or teaching assistant, you could be paired up with a student to work on specific language skills during a regular class or at a different time. Remember, you don't need to speak any foreign languages in order to help out! We only speak English in class ☺

Kid's Worship Returns on January 11th, 2009

Children in Kindergarten and older can opt to leave our main worship service after the children's moment and participate in a "kid-friendly" bible lesson with the same message as Pastor Ricky's sermon. Kid's Worship will meet in *The Garden*. Children will return to the Worship Service to join the congregation in singing the Closing Hymn. The parents/guardians of the children that attend this worship time must volunteer at least one time during the schedule rotation. Kid's Worship Time will not be held on the Sundays when the kids go on their Outreach Trips or on Children's Sunday.

For children that would like to remain in the worship service there are colorful bags hanging in the back of the church filled with things to keep your child(ren) occupied. We do ask that at the end of the service, you return the bag to the rack and discard all trash.

Prayer Bears Available

Prayer Bears will be given out to by the children to anyone who is sick, homebound, hospitalized or just need encouragement. The bears will remind people that they are receiving prayer and support from the children and youth at CUMC. This project gives the children a chance to reach out to people in need. If

Thanks to our Volunteers.....

Please take a moment to thank the volunteers that work with the children and youth. The screening process for volunteers and staff that work with children and youth at CUMC is extensive. We take extreme measures to safeguard our children and youth while they are participating in events sponsored by our church. A picture ID identifies each volunteer that is Safe Sanctuary Certified. 99% of the volunteers have also completed the certification process for first aide, CPR and AED. :

State Police Criminal History Report

A report of criminal history information obtained from the Pennsylvania State Police

Childline Report

A certification obtained from the Department of Public Welfare as to whether the applicant is named in the central register as the perpetrator of a founded report of child abuse, with a founded case of child abuse

FBI Clearance and Fingerprinting

A report of federal criminal history record information and fingerprints

Volunteer Application

A written application must be submitted by all volunteers.

Reference Checks

A minimum of two (2) Reference Checks shall be made on all new applicants for employment or volunteer service.

Training

A video presentation is used to train new volunteers on Safe Sanctuary policies and procedures.

Covenant Statement

A covenant for the member to sign stating that in the event the member is recruited to work with children or youth, he or she agrees to follow the church's policies and procedures for the prevention of child abuse.



CUMC GIFT CARD FUNDRAISER

CUMC has started a gift card fundraiser that will occur every 2-3 months throughout the year. CUMC makes a percentage of each card purchased. The percentages range from 1.5% to 25%.

Gift cards are not just for gifts.

Purchase a few Wal Mart gift cards to use for purchasing all of the Easter candy/gifts you will need this year.

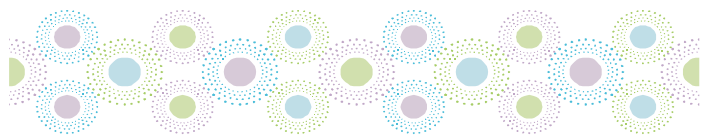

Finance Team Corner

If you were worshipping with us on Sunday, December 14, 2008 you saw the new partition doors that separate the sanctuary from Wesley Hall. These doors were possible because of your pledges and donations. The Sunday School has started a mid-week ministry for pre-teens and teens and has started computer classes. These programs are supported by your pledges and donations. The next time you worship with us be sure to check out the new microphones and music stands, these were purchased with your donations and pledges. The church thanks you for your continued support!!

CUMC relies heavily on a seasonal increase in contributions each year starting around Thanksgiving. These contributions help support the work of the church now and throughout the year. During this season, please consider demonstrating appreciation for your own good fortune or good health by making an additional contribution or, if you haven't done so already, by committing to a consistent giving plan.

Finance Update through November 30, 2008:

Pledges are slightly behind budget through November 2008. Cash in through November 30 was \$205,648. Expenses paid for the same period totaled \$222,933 for a loss of \$20,285.

Annual Stewardship Campaign:

Pledge statements with your giving through December 13, 2008 will be available after the church service on December 21, 2008. If they are not picked up, they will be mailed on December 22, 2008.

Great news - If you haven't submitted your pledge for 2009 there is still time!! Pledge cards are available at the church office and can be picked up or mailed to you. Please call Joni or Pastor Ricky for a card, (610) 828-1250 and return it to the church via mail or place it in the offering plate on Sunday... After your pledge is received, a confirmation letter will be mailed to you.

If you are interested in having your 2009 pledge automatically debited from your bank account, please contact Brian Backenstose, the Finance Secretary.

The boxes of 2009 giving envelopes will be available for pick-up after the service on December 21 and December 28. Any that haven't been picked up by December 29, 2008 will be mailed.

Fundraising Update:

The church still has cookbooks for sale. These make great gifts for the holidays, as well as housewarming gifts and bridal shower gifts. Please see the head usher or contact the church office if you are interested in purchasing this unique gift filled with great recipes from our congregation. The price is \$10.

We received 20 orders for gift cards and the church made approximately \$500 on these 20 orders. We will run this fundraiser throughout the year, so if you didn't get your order in for this deadline, look for the next order date in February. These make great gifts for the Easter, Mother's Day, birthdays, etc but they can also be used by you when you shop or visit these merchants. eScrip Program:

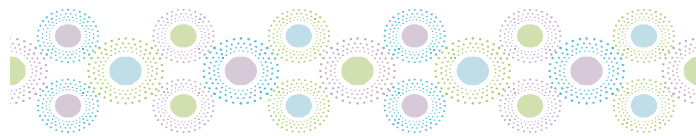
Our church participates in the escrip program (also known as the Genuardi's program). This program is much larger than shopping at Genuardi's.

There are hundreds of brand name merchants online that participate in the escrip program. Do you plan to do any holiday shopping online this year? The eScrip Online Mall is the perfect way to earn up to 16% for the church for shopping at over 1,000 of your favorite online merchants. If you don't remember to visit the online mall first, simply download Autoearn, a free software tool that will automatically earn contributions at participating merchants.

You can also register your debit and credit cards on the escrip website and a portion of what you spend on these cards is credited to the church's account. Use your cards as you normally would, eScrip tracks your purchases and credits the church with the applicable percentage of your purchases. Also enjoy the rewards of dining out. Earn up to 5% each time you dine using your debit or credit cards that are registered with escrip. You can search the escrip website for participating restaurants.

Escrip sign-up is easy and costs nothing. If you have access to the internet, you can visit www.eScrip.com and register for the program and identify Conshohocken United Methodist Church as the group that will benefit from your spending. If you don't have access to the internet, you can sign up using your Genuardi's card number at your local Genuardi's. You can also contact Nancy Maguire or Jennifer Kriebel, and they can assist in signing you up for the program.

We hope to utilize the computers in the Sunday School computer lab to assist those who don't have access to the internet to sign-up for the program in the near future. We will keep you posted on dates when these computers might be available.



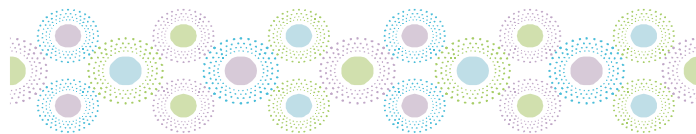
